SUNSET & ECO SHADE SHELTERS

CURVED ROOFS STYLISHLY MODERN DURABLE STRENGTH.

LOCATION

Fort Worth is a hub of culture, commerce, and innovation that embodies the spirit of Texas. Known for its renowned museums, entertainment districts, and thriving economy, Fort Worth stands as a testament to Texas' economic power and cultural richness. Iconic sites like the historic Fort Worth Stockyards showcase the area's mix of tradition and modernity.

Trinity Metro provides an extensive public transportation system in Fort Worth, allowing visitors and locals to easily access neighborhoods, lively entertainment venues, and sporting events. In 2024, Trinity Metro launched the Orange Line, featuring a distinctive Western theme and orange color, to connect the Fort Worth Stockyards and downtown Fort Worth.

PROJECT SCOPE

In Ft. Worth, Tolar is collaborating with Trinity Metro to design, produce, and install state-of-the-art bus shelters and EcoShades for 900 bus stops over three years. Tolar provided more than 254 custom Sunset series bus shelters, EcoShades, and other amenities in 2024 as part of this agreement.

Sunset shelters on the Orange Line will feature agency branding and customized details, including art glass designed to match the unique look of the Orange Line buses.

The Sunset bus shelter features 3/8" clear tempered glass panels and a radius roof design with a nominal dripline along a fully welded roof structure. The shelters also include 80W roof-mounted solar panels with integrated battery storage that power the RMS80F Solar Lighting System, providing under-roof security lighting with five-day minimum autonomous operation through an 8W LED light fixture. A matching roof and footprint attachment are on both end walls for future ad kiosk retrofit. All parts are finished in sparkle silver with a clear coat as selected from TCI standard RAL color deck. Each Sunset shelter is equipped with an advertising display, Mesa benches with seat delineators, wind-protecting glass walls, and solar security lighting.

The Sunset EcoShades are 6-ft wide monopole shelters, uniquely designed for locations with narrow or limited right-of-way. The EcoShades feature a Sunset radius



roof design with a 6-ft x 6-ft roof dripline, all-aluminum construction, and a fully welded roof structure. Two fully welded bench seats are mounted on both sides of the center column, providing seating at smaller bus stops. All parts are finished in a super-durable baked powder coat.

SIGNATURE CUSTOM SANTA ANA, CA

Papel Picado themed shelters bring culture and color to Santa Ana.

Bringing the delicate intricacies of popular “papel picado” Mexican folk art to life, these 41 custom-built 14-ft to 27-ft shelters include rugged steel structures enhanced with colorful acrylic roof panels, perforated benches, and vividly colored wall elements.

BRAZOS SIGNATURE AUSTIN, TX

Part of Capital Metro’s Coordinated Bus Stop Street Furniture Program delivering functional street furniture of exceptional design quality.

This 12-ft shelter incorporates a radius roof, rolled posts rear wind screen, and branding banner.



SIGNATURE SUNSET SAN DIEGO, CA

Three decades designing and fabricating bus shelters, street furniture, and digital solutions.

17-ft advertising shelters with agency branding make a big impact on the streets of San Diego. Passengers enjoy an integrated passenger information display case, Mesa benches, pole mounted trash/recycle bin, and dusk-to-dawn solar illumination in the roof and display case.

BUS RAPID TRANSIT BOSTON, MA

Nine BRT shelters in five distinctive Signature Sunset models make a modern statement.

36-ft x 7-ft BRT stations with 3/8-in cleat tempered glass, station location branding, LED illumination, housing for various amenities, slat benches, and agency branding marker.



SIGNATURE VOYAGER MAX LAKE GEORGE, NY

Beautifully designed to embrace the picturesque tourist town of Lake George.

A 62-ft custom axel open canopy shelter with 8-mm bronze twin-wall polycarbonate roof panels with solar illumination. Mesa platform benches with seat delineators, custom passenger information kiosk, and durable baked premium powder coat finish complete the shelter.

SIGNATURE SUNSET ECOSHADE FORT WORTH, TX

Uniquely designed to provide shade and comfort for narrow spaces.

These 6-ft wide monopole shelters fit perfectly in limited right-of-way locations, providing solar-powered security lighting, agency-provided ePaper real-time information signage, and seating for two plus ADA seating space.



CUSTOM VOYAGER SAN LUIS OBISPO, CA

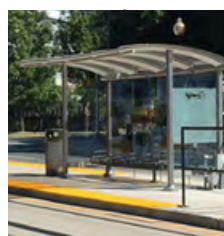
Maximizing passenger amenities for comfort and convenience.

Four 17-ft spoke-style cantilever shelters offer flexible length adjustments to provide maximum shade. Amenities include steel strap benches, low-draw LED lighting, and back-to-back media display kiosks.

SIGNATURE SUNSET GREENSBORO, NC

State of the art solar powers these city shelters.

This 10-ft shelter is NCDOT PEP approved with its all-aluminum construction and fully welded roof with 3/8-in clear tempered safety glass showcasing highly visible city branding. LED security lighting powered with an RMS50 solar lighting system, including 50W photovoltaic roof mounted panels, provides dusk-to-dawn illumination using UL-listed components. A 7-ft Mesa aluminum frame recycle slat bench provides seating.



BUS RAPID TRANSIT CHARLOTTE, NC

Various Tolar-designed shelters greet riders as they begin their travels on BRT lines in their community.

This 16-ft Signature Sunset shelter sits along a streetcar line sporting custom art glass panels unique to each stop location. The shelters feature extra deep roofs, bronze tint heat-formed radius roof panels, wide and narrow end walls for specific location requirements, and electric security lighting in rear beam for passenger comfort.
