### LOCATION

The City of Riverside is located in southern California. Named for its location beside the Santa Ana River, Riverside is the most populous city in the Inland Empire.

Founded in the early 1870s, Riverside paved the way for California's citrus industry. Surrounded by mountains and home to over 300,000 people, the city's thriving educational institutions, multitude of parks and outdoor spaces, and varied business industries provides something for everyone.

Whether heading to Riverside's vibrant downtown or home to one of its 28 neighborhoods, Riverside Transit Agency, covers the community's nearly 82 square miles. La Sierra Station is Riverside's second largest station served by Metrolink.

### PROJECT

The 30-ft by 7-ft custom Signature shelters throughout the station support transit riders making connections between Metrolink and local RTA transit routes. Decorative battens and radius posts support wide aluminum roof panels\* providing shade over the spacious seating with matching trash receptacle. Schedules and routes are prominently displayed in integrated map cases and each shelter provides security lighting utilizing four solar-powered, UL-listed, dusk-to-dawn LED lighting units\* manufactured by Urban Solar.

A coordinated effort was made to ensure these station shelters align with Tolar-fabricated BRT shelters located throughout Riverside.

*\*Tolar assembled the roofs and lighting in its Corona-based manufacturing facility, delivering complete easy-to-install units to the job site.*

## DOWNTOWN TRANSIT MALL

22-ft x 10-ft transit shelters located at Courthouse Park in Fresno, California, also known as the Downtown Transit Mall. Eleven bus shelters in all are dramatically lit with energy-efficient blue LED lights designed by Teter Architects and Engineers. The Tolar team fabricated the shelters, roof glazing system and all stainless steel accents including the unique lean rails around the dual post columns.

## LOS ANGELES SOUTHWEST COLLEGE TRANSIT STATION

Tolar Manufacturing adapted 16-foot shelters from its Signature Custom line to form a transit station for Los Angeles Southwest College. Working closely with the school's project architect the Tolar team created a solution that serves the transportation needs of the school's growing enrollment, while meeting site restrictions and reflecting the school's powerfully branded identity. Illuminating the bus stops with environmentally-responsible solar powered lighting was another critical element of the project.

Other environmentally-friendly features include a custom powder coat finish that emits minimal VOC's into the local environment, seating that features HDPE slats around an architectural aluminum frame.



## SUNSET TRANSIT SHELTERS - GOLETA

Tolar Manufacturing Company fabricated this Signature Sunset shelter beautifully surrounded by lush growth in Goleta, California.

This 10-ft bus shelter provides shade and comfort for commuters who work in and around this growing commercial park. Supporting three Santa Barbara Metropolitan Transit District routes, passengers can rest their feet at the Mesa-style bench that includes seat delineators, while taking comfort in the shade provided by 3/8" heat-formed bronze and polycarbonate curved roof panels held by multi-channel horizontal and vertical aluminum posts. Decorative spun escutcheons round out the modern aesthetic.

Other amenities include a matching trash receptacle, branded route flag, and easy-to-read, pole-mounted schedule display.
