### LOCATION

Tampa is a city located on the Gold Coast of the state of Florida and is the city seat for Hillsborough County. As the third most populous city in the state, Tampa's 398,000+ citizens rely in part on Hillsborough Area Regional Transit (HART) Authority to move throughout the community. Critical to the bus riding experience is where passengers begin and end their trips – at safe and comfortable bus stops.

### PROJECT SCOPE

In 2021, Tolar Manufacturing Company, was awarded a five-year contract to design and build bus shelters and street furniture for Hillsborough Area Regional Transit (HART) Authority. HART's aging bus shelters are now being replaced with Tolar Manufacturing Company's sleek, modern, and popular Signature Crescent series shelters, which are known for their kit-of-parts, easy-to-install approach.

For Tampa, the 13-foot shelters capture the heart of

the city's love of the Tampa Bay Buccaneers as well as HART's own agency's branding, with a modern aesthetic that creates a true Sense of Place™ for the greater Tampa area.

With the community in mind, these durable shelters are equipped for the humid climate with breeze-friendly back paneling, sturdy Mesa benches and lean rails, and 32-gallon trash receptacles with rain diverters. Each shelter is available with UL-listed LED solar illumination and a SmartLink controller allowing for remote monitoring of the solar performance.

**SIGNATURE CRESCENT TAMPA, FL**  
A “Kit of Parts” approach.

These 13-ft bus shelters were created in keeping with Tolar’s “Kit of Parts” approach. Available with optional end walls, agency branding, dusk-to-dawn solar powered LED illumination and a SmartLink controller allowing for remote monitoring of the solar performance. Amenities include a Mesa bench with a center armrest and 32-gallon trash receptacle.



**SIGNATURE CUSTOM RADIUS ORLANDO, FL**  
Radius roof showcases revenue-generating display advertising.

These 9-ft and 13-ft bus shelters are configured to accommodate both advertising and non-advertising options. Shelters features curved radius roof and open end wall supported by an angled front post along with a perforated metal screen rear wall. Perforated metal benches and 32-gallon steel strap trash receptacles are illuminated by a solar powered system.

**EURO SHELTER GAINESVILLE, FL**  
Reflecting the character of the community.

This 16-ft x 8-ft bus shelter features bronze lexan roof panels supported by custom posts with escutcheons. The herringbone design on the rear wall and end panels characterize the surrounding tree-lined neighborhood. A map case, steel strap street bench, and trash receptacle round out the shelter.



**SIGNATURE CRESCENT TALLAHASSEE, FL**

**Bus shelters built for narrow spaces.**

Built in both 10- and 12-ft lengths, these bus shelters meet StarMetro’s size and foundation requirements for narrow spaces while offering solid aluminum roof panels to provide maximum passenger shade during hot Florida months. Solar powers important rooftop security lighting and revenue-generating advertising through oversize displays lit with solar illumination.



**BRT JACKSONVILLE, FL**  
Completely customizable BRT solutions with digital information kiosks.

15-ft Signature BRT shelters with back-to-back media display kiosk, and custom branding over perforated metal panels. Project also included 10-ft free-standing digital display kiosks with 32-in LCD digital screens in NEMA-rated enclosures with backlit LED map cases placed below digital screen.



**BRT GULL WING TRANSIT HUB JACKSONVILLE, FL**  
Maximizing passenger seating for comfort and convenience.

Serving JTA’s First Coast Flyer, this University Transit Hub provides ample seating and high visibility branding adding to neighborhood improvements.

**EURO SERIES MIAMI, FL**  
Branded shelters in various configurations with minimal unique parts customize the transit riding experience.

This 13-ft Euro max roof shelter features white Lexan roof panels with 3/8-in glass walls, aluminum support posts, city logo on rear glass, and 8-ft perforated metal bench with seat delineators.



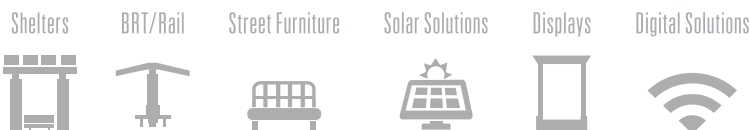
**SIGNATURE EMPIRE ST. PETERSBURG, FL**

This 32-ft shelter sports a modern Empire flat angled roof with a 32-ft x 6-ft dripline and electrical access in rear post to power LED security lighting. Perforated aluminium rear panels showcase custom printed agency logo while 3/8” tempered glass end panels feature high visibility branding.
